The Global & International Studies (GIST) certificate is a 12-unit/4-course certificate designed for working professionals and KU graduate students from other disciplines. The certificate requires completion of one core course (GIST 701 or GIST 702) an elective in a regional area, an elective in a topical area, and one general internationally-focused elective.
